

PACT Meeting  
Held at the Old Church Rooms  
On Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2018

Those present: Cllr Rod Mckerlich, PCSO Hywel Arkonopolus, Cllr David Suthers and members of the public - DC, DW, TG, VA

Apologies for absence: Cllr Ralph Vaughan, PC Helen Abdullah and CW.

Councillors Report: RM reported that he has followed up on the road accidents at Windsor Road/Drysgol Road to be informed that the cost of lit road signs would be £3200. New LED street lighting in the village is causing some concern for cyclists and pedestrians away from the direct lit areas. The installation of these new lights will save CCC £800k in a full year.

The Plas Dwr development will start work on the new junction at Llantrisant Road/Heol Isaf is scheduled to between 9.30am and 3.30pm each day. It has been suggested that this should be changed to 7pm to 7am plus weekends to reduce the total work time to weeks rather than months.

The 20mph zones around the two primary schools are scheduled for February.

TG raised the problem with youths using the car park at the station for leisure activities and disturbing the neighbourhood. The police have promised to patrol the area from time to time.

DW stated that there are still problems at the play area in Radyr Woods with school pupils causing a nuisance during the day, in school time! The question was asked whether installation of CCTV would be a deterrent.

Cars parked in the road opposite the Comprehensive School are causing obstructions being parked across the footpath. It is believed that some of these cars belong to pupils at the school. Police will patrol and warn owners that it is illegal to park on the pavements, causing obstruction.

PCSO HA reported that there had been 6 criminal incidents during the last month including 2 assaults, 1 burglary, 2 shoplifting and 1 theft of money.
