Re: Bus services to the Ffordd Treforgan estate, Morganstown

During a recent street surgery in Morganstown, I learnt of the problems faced by some elderly residents relating to the local bus service.

I spoke to an elderly couple living off Ffordd Treforgan. They raised concerns over the distance they are required to walk in order to access the nearest available public transport. The no. 63 bus is the only service to the estate. It stops at just one stop in the middle of the estate, and very infrequently. The bus service they had previously used was cancelled around a year ago. They said that it had stopped at other points in the estate, which made it far easier for them to access. The couple have no independent transport, and one of them suffers from Parkinson's disease. They feel they now have no means of transport available to them.

I would be grateful if you could investigate the possibility of increasing the stops on the route to incorporate residents further away from the existing stop (Ffordd y Berllan), and also investigate the possibility of increasing the frequency of the service, in order that the service is accessible to as many residents as possible.
