

PACT Notes of meeting held on 2nd March 2010, 7pm, Radyr Old Church Rooms

Dr Vaughan opened the meeting and welcomed the attendees.

PCSO Helen Coleman gave an introduction as the new PCSO to the area.

Notes of the last meeting were accepted by all.

SPEEDING ON HEOL ISAF.

Cllr Rod Mckerlich stated that the problem with the driver feedback signs has been rectified and are now working. It has been noticed that the speed at which vehicles now travel has seen a significant reduction. Dr Vaughan enquired about the possibility of having more introduced in the Radyr & Morganstown area.

JUNIOR PCSO SCHEME.

Junior PCSO scheme is to be introduced to Radyr Primary and Bryn Deri Primary. Once this is up and running it is hoped that it will be of assistance with the parking issues currently in the area.

It was reported that the council are considering changing the time of the weekly bin collections so that they no longer coincide with the rush hour and school run during the morning.

NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH.

It was reported that a letter from the neighbourhood watch co-ordinator is to be published in the next issue of the Radyr Chain.

PC Tebbutt reported that there has been an arrest of a male for the recent spate of vehicle crime and currently remanded in custody for several offences linked to this.

YOUTH PACT ISSUES.

A youth PACT was held at Radyr Comprehensive on Tuesday 2nd February, with great success. Over 28 young people attended the meeting, also in attendance were local youth workers and members of the Community Council. The youth raised issues about the use of the Mosquito at the Spar, CCTV & signs at the skate park and the possibility of having a shelter installed in the area designated for their use. A future meeting is to be arranged.

ANY OTHER ISSUES.

Get well soon wishes were sent to Cath Mangles from the PACT committee, wishing her a swift recovery.

Residents asked about the possibility of having a designated bus stop between Windsor Road and Station Road. Cllr Mckerlich is to look into the request with the council.

Dr Vaughan read out a letter he had received from Chief Superintendent Josh Jones with regards to the possibility of cancelling the next PACT meeting should a General Election being announced, and a new venue being enquired about for future meetings.

Local residents have stated that they have noticed an increase in the level of dog fouling along Heol Isaf.
