

**NOTES OF THE PACT MEETING HELD ON THE 29th APRIL 2013.**

**PRESENT: R S VAUGHAN-CHAIRMAN,COUNCILLOR R McKERLICH,P C HUW THOMAS AND FIFTEEN REPRESENTATIVES.**

**1 APOLOGIES WERE RECEIVED FROM FOUR REPRESENTATIVES.**

**2 THE CHAIRMAN INTRODUCED P C S O BETHAN LANGDEN.**

**3 THE NOTES OF THE LAST PACT MEETING WERE RECEIVED AND SIGNED AS A TRUE RECORD.**

**4 THE CHAIRMAN AND OTHER REPRESENTATIVES HAD VISITED EXHIBITIONS IN CARDIFF REGARDING THE CARDIFF LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN.THERE WAS NO NEED TO SUBMIT ANY FURTHER COMMENTS AT THE MOMENT.**

**5 THE REPLY FROM INSPECTOR P ARKONTOPOULES WAS RECEIVED.THERE FOLLOWED A DISCUSSION AS TO HOW THE PUBLIC COULD ASSIST THE POLICE REGARDING DRUG RELATED ISSUES.THE REPRESENTATIVES WERE URGED TO ENCOURAGE THE PUBLIC TO REPORT ALL SUCH INCIDENTS TO THE POLICE.IN ADDITION,A LETTER WOULD BE DRAWN UP BY THE POLICE AND THE MEMBERS OF THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH (N H W)FOR DISTRIBUTION IN THE APPROPRIATE AREAS .**

**6 THE FLOW OF HEAVY GOODS VEHICULES ALONG HEOL ISAF WILL CONTINUED TO BE MONITORED BY THE TRAFFIC POLICE.THERE HAVE BEEN NO PROSECUTIONS.**

**7 THE POLICE HAVE RECEIVED NO COMPLAINTS IN REGARD TO MOTOR BIKE USAGE IN THE LOCAL WOODS.**

**8 COUNCILLOR R McKERLICH SPOKE TO HIS APRIL REPORT WHICH HAD BEEN PUBLISHED ON THE COUNCIL WEBPAGE.THE MAIN CONCERNS WERE THE CURRENT STATE OF THE ROADS IN THE R AND M AREAS AND THE AVAILABILABLE PLACES FOR PUPILS UNDER 11YEARS OF AGE.BOTH WERE INCLUDED IN CONTINUED DISCUSSIONS**

**9 MESSERS BATEMAN AND CARGILL PRESENTED A SHORT UPDATE OF THE LOCAL ACTIVITIES OF THE NHW.**

**10 P C THOMAS BROUGHT THE MEETING UP TO DATE IN REGARD TO POLICING THE R & M AREAS.PC THOMAS WAS CURENTLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE R & M,PENTYRCH, CREIGIAU,GWAELOD AND ST FAGANS AREAS.HOWEVER,THERE WOULD BE AN ADDITIONAL FOUR PCSO'S AND MOBILE UNITS TO ASSIST.THE CHAIRMAN EXPRESSED CONSIDERABLE CONCERN THAT WHILE THE POPULATION IN THESE AREAS CONTINUED TO RISE,THERE APPEARED TO BE A COMMENSURATE DECREASE IN POLICE PRESENCE PARTICULARLY BY FULLY TRAINED POLICE OFFICERS.THIS SENTIMENT WAS FULLY ENDORSED BY THE REPRESENTATIVES.**

**11 A LETTER FROM REVEREND K WEBSTER TO THE CHIEF CONSTABLE AND THE SUBSEQUENT REPLY WERE RECEIVED.THE MAIN ISSUES WERE THE LACK OF A ZEBRA CROSSING AT THE BOTTOM OF MIN-Y-COED.THE LACK OF A MINI ROUND ABOUT AT THE JUNCTION OF BRYN DERWEN AND HEOL ISAF,THE STATE OF THE LOCAL ROADS AND THE TRAFFIC FLOW ALONG HEOL ISAF.THE CHAIRMAN STATED THAT THESE ISSUES HAD BEEN IN THE FOREFRONT OF CONCERNS BY ALL THE LOCAL BODIES FOR SOME YEARS.COUNCILLOR R MCKERLICH CONFIRMED THAT ALL THESE ISSUES WERE UNDER DISCUSSION AT THE CARDIFF COUNCIL.THE LACK OF PROGRESS WAS DUE SOLELY TO FINANCIAL ISSUES .**

**12 MR ALAN MICHAEL WOULD BE HOSTING AN EVENING AT THE INTERNATIONAL HOTEL IN TONGWYNLAIS AT 19-00H ON TUESDAY MAY 28TH.IT WAS HOPED THAT AS MANY AS POSSIBLE OF LOCAL RESIDENTS WOULD ATTEND.THE CHAIRMAN WOULD BE UNABLE TO ATTEND AS HE WOULD BE IN A MEETING IN MANCHESTER.**

**13 ANY OTHER BUSINESS.**

**IT WAS ANNOUNCED THAT CERTAIN YELLOW LINES WOULD RECEIVE ANOTHER COAT OF PAINT WHILE,IN ADDITION ,OTHER AREAS WOULD RECEIVE A DE NOVO RESTRICTION USING THE SAME METHOD .THERE WAS A COMPLAINT REGARDING CAR PARKING ON THE GRASS VERGE IN MORGANSTOWN.THE**

**POLICE WERE UNABLE TO ASSIST UNLESS THERE WAS AN OBSTRUCTION ON THE PAVEMENT.HOWEVER,THEY WOULD CONTACT THE CARDIFF C E O 'S.**

**14 THE PRIORITIES FOR THE NEXT PACT MEETING WOULD BE ISSUES SURROUNDING THE DRUG PROBLEM,THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC ALONG HEOL ISAF AND ASSOCIATED SAFETY ISSUES.**
