

**Notes of the Partnership and Community Trust [PACT] Meeting held at 19-00H on

1 Apologies were received from Councillor R McKerlich and Mr D Suthers

4 There were two additional hearings by the Inspector regarding the C L D Plan .Radyr and Morganstown were represented. The various bodies from the North West Group were also represented. Each representative would be allowed TEN MINUTES ONLY TO PRESENT THEIR POINTS. The Inspector would produce her report in November. However, a definitive plan for 600 houses at the west end of HEOL ISAF had been submitted

5 The September report from Councillor R Mackerlich which had been published on the web was received.

6 Mr D Cargill gave an update on the Neighbourhood Watch. It would appear that the East and West Areas of Cardiff were to be reunited.

The Chairman reported that the issues regarding the installation of an A E D on Station Road had been resolved. It was hoped that the installation would go ahead in early October.
